In December 2006 the Ifa Lethu Foundation was awarded a planning grant of \$16 000 in order to allow it to consult with and seek input from local and international partners in preparation for a funding proposal to be submitted to the Mellon Foundation in the fall of 2007. Such input was vital for the preparation of an extensive and concrete proposal.



This resulted in a series of two workshops being held by Ifa Lethu at its offices. Participants included leading South African institutions identified for their involvement and expertise in the field of heritage and research. These included third-level education represented by the Universities of Cape Town, Fort Hare, Kwazulu-Natal, the Western Cape and the Witwatersrand and the University of South Africa. Other leading cultural and intellectual organizations consulted included the Pretoria Art Museum, the state archives and key non-governmental organizations such as the Steve Biko Foundation.
