"They communicated anger, sadness, and even joy that an end of apartheid era would surely come. The Ifa Lethu collection is our only glimpse of the life in the townships in those hard years," the minister said.

"We owe it to the men and women whose work is displayed and some of them are no longer with us to see their work," he said.

More importantly, Minister Jordan said government was committed to advance art by mobilising public funds and give continuous support to the arts. - BuaNews
